



ROAD WORKS

GWMWater has reminded landowners and harvest contractors in the Dimboola, Wail, Pimpinio and Horsham areas to be aware of works taking place on minor roads as part of the channel decommissioning project.

Managing Director Jeff Rigby said that the works, which included the removal of road culverts and channel backfilling on road reserves, were expected to be completed by the end of the year.

“We understand that harvest is a busy time for landowners and contractors. We encourage them to make themselves aware of where works are being undertaken in their area to minimise inconvenience during the harvest period and to ensure their safety”, he said.

“Project contractors will make every effort to limit inconvenience to minor road users during this period”.

All sites will be managed with appropriate road signage in accordance with the Road Management Act 2004, Worksite Safety and the Traffic Management Code of Practice.
