



Goroke Sewerage Works - Stage 2 progresses

The Goroke Sewerage Scheme is progressing well with Stage 2 of the project expected to be completed by late July 2024.

Contractor S&R Engineering and Construction Pty Ltd will start work on the second stage of the STED (Septic Tank Effluent Drainage) sewerage network in Goroke in late March 2024.

Managing Director, Mark Williams said, "This sewerage network will facilitate the transfer of wastewater from customers' existing septic tanks to Goroke's Wastewater Treatment Plant, located on Kiely Street in Goroke."

Contractor CHS Group are progressing the construction of a new sewerage pump station on Natimuk-Francis Road, Goroke. These works are expected to be completed in June this year.

Goroke customers in the Stage 2 area are required to connect to the Goroke Sewerage Scheme within two years of the sewerage network being declared. Information on how to connect and the associated costs will be provided to customers as the works progress.

GWMWater is working in partnership with the West Wimmera Shire Council to bring a sewerage service to Goroke, contributing to the prosperity and future growth of the town.
