

Goroke Sewerage Scheme Project Consultative Group – Terms of Reference

BACKGROUND

The Goroke Sewerage Scheme Project Consultative Group (The PCG) is a consultative committee of the GWMWater Goroke Sewerage Scheme Project Team (The Project Team).

The PCG's role is to provide a conduit between the Goroke community and the Project Team in the development of detailed design and implementation of the sewerage scheme. The PCG will be informed of major project developments. The PCG will provide assistance, specifically in respect to identifying issues, providing advice and views on potential issues that may impact on the community.

MEMBERSHIP

Membership of the Consultative Committee will be based on invitation to Goroke landowners and community representatives and representatives of West Wimmera Shire Council as follows:

West Wimmera Shire Council	Three representatives
GWMWater	Three representatives
Goroke landowners and community rep.	Up to four representatives

The GWMWater representative will Chair the group.

FUNCTIONING OF THE GROUP

The PCG will meet as required for the duration of the project.

Administrative support will be provided by GWMWater, with minutes taken of each meeting and provided to the Project Team for consideration.

No member of the Committee will make statements to the media on behalf of the Committee without the approval of the GWMWater Managing Director. If statements are made by a member without this approval it should be clearly stated that the comments are their own personal views and not those of the Group or GWMWater.

Quorums for meetings of the group will require the attendance of at least 50% of members.
